## Have surplus stock? We have the solution.

Daily Bread Food Bank works with over 70 grocery stores across Toronto to rescue unsold food and distributes it to food banks and meal programs across the city.

**Daily Bread accepts inventory that is damaged, mislabeled, over-stocked, nearing or past the best-before date. This includes:**

- Shelf-stable and non-perishable food up to **6 months** after the best-before date.
- Frozen food, including **meat and seafood** that is frozen **on or before** the best-before date.
- All food items with mislabeling or damaged packaging (seal must be intact, must be safe for consumption).
- Household items, including cleaning and sanitary products, hygiene and wellness products, pet food, diapers and more.

**We are equipped to support you, we have:**

- A fully equipped cold supply chain.
- Free and flexible pickups (minimum 1 pallet) offered weekly, bi-weekly, or ad-hoc
- A fleet of 26' and 53' trucks operating 6 days a week.
- 170,000 ft<sup>2</sup> warehouse and 5,000+ ft<sup>2</sup> of cold/frozen storage.
- Food handling certified professionals and quality assurance supervisors.
- Ability to repack and/or relabel private label donations.
- Capacity to sort mixed product donation bins.
